BOARD OF ASSESSMENT AND APPEALS – GREYLOCK ENERGY, LLC (See copies attached)

Randolph County Assessor, Phyllis Yokum said that her office received one appeal for taxes and it has to be addressed by the board of appeals in the month of October. She said this appeal was asked for back in February from Greylock Energy, LLC. She said in 2019 they did not get the relief they requested because they did not provide the proper paperwork. She said now in 2020 they are appealing again but they did supply to proper paperwork this year. She said she has been working with them and she showed the Commission the paperwork and calculations for the exoneration for 2020. She said they provided her with three years of income and expense. She said they are a pipeline company and now the pipeline is at a standstill. She said she worked with her attorney to come up with the adjustments on the 2020 value. She said the original amount of taxes owed would have been \$24,208.46. They will receive a credit of \$6,536.46 which will be credited on the 2021 taxes. This year they will pay the full amount of taxes owed. Commissioner See moved to approve the agreement between Randolph County and Greylock Pipeline, LLC, as submitted.
