At a regular session of the County Commission in and for the aforesaid County and State, at the James F. Cain Court House Annex, on the 21st day of December, 2023 at 1:30 p.m.

Present: Randolph County Commission President David Kesling and Commissioners Chris See and Chris Siler

Meeting called to order by Commissioner Kesling

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

MINUTES:

Commissioner Siler moved to approve the minutes from the regular meeting that was held on December 7, 2023, as submitted. All yes – Motion passed unanimously

REPORTS:

Erin Golden, Director of North Central Community Corrections, appeared before the Commission. She said there are currently 113 participants on the program and the program has saved the County \$764,383.25 in regional jail bills so far this fiscal year. (See copy attached)

Rhett Dusenberry from Congressman Mooney's Office said Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.

Brenda Wiseman, Randolph County Clerk, said the filing period for the upcoming election is January 8th thru January 27th 2024 and her office will be open on the last day of filing from 9-12. She said her office has the filing packets ready if anyone would want to come pick one up.

Randolph County Assessor, Phyllis Yokum gave an update on the TIFF district. She showed a map that her office put together with all the properties that are included in the City of Elkins Tiff district. She said there are 792 parcels included in the TIFF. She said this has been a lot of work on her office. She said she has two personal property Clerks working on this. She said they made up a spreadsheet and are going through each parcel one by one. She said she probably won't have solid figures until March when she does her certification. She said this is going to continue for the next 30 years and they will have to do all this work every year. She said this is a very large TIFF with 792 parcels involved. She asked if the County can be reimbursed for this extra work? She said the County and City should work together to use some of the TIFF money to pay for this extra work and to pay for the vendors she has to use to help with this. Commissioner Kesling said for her to keep track of the time so they can bill the City of Elkins. He said for the Sheriff's Office to keep track of their time too because they will be involved in this also. He said he is so frustrated with this TIFF.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Commissioner Kesling announced that the next regular meeting will be on January 4, 2024 at 1:30 p.m. He also said budget requests from any of the offices for the upcoming fiscal year are due to the Commission Office by January 31, 2024. He said the Courthouse will be closed Christmas Day and New Year's Day and the Governor has issued tomorrow a holiday for State Employees. He said the County Commission has followed suit with what the Governor has said so that is a practice they will continue. He said if the Governor gives the state employees off then the county employees will be off also.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION:

CONSIDER APPROVAL OF COUNTY HOLIDAYS FOR 2024 (See copy attached)

Commissioner Kesling read out loud the list of the 19 County holidays for 2024. Commissioner Siler moved to approve the County holidays for 2024, as submitted. All yes – Motion passed unanimously

BUDGETARY REQUEST FROM INTERACT CHILDREN'S MUSEUM (See copy attached)

Lisa Martin and Michael Hayes appeared before the Commission on behalf of the Interact Children's Museum. Ms. Martin said last year they came and asked the Commission for funding for their summer series and the Commission helped with that and they bought nice new outdoor exhibits. She said they are currently a mobile museum but they want to have a permanent structure. She said they want to open the doors in 2024 but they need a building, need to staff it and open the doors. She said this lets the kids go beyond the structure of the classroom. She said they want this to be a major attraction in Elkins. She said they want to make it affordable for everyone so they will be getting grants and funding. She said they are asking to be put into the County's budget because they will need ongoing funds once they get the building. She said they are asking for \$5,000.00 in funding. Commissioner Kesling said next year's budget will be very unpredictable with the TIFF. He said it is easier for the Commission to give them funding from Hotel/Motel Tax funds. He said he loves their passion for this project. He said the Commission could give them \$5,000.00 now and then they could come back after July 1st and they could possibly give them some more. Commissioner Kesling moved to approve the funding request from Interact Children's Museum in the amount of \$5,000.00 and that is to be taken out of Hotel/Motel Tax Funds. All yes – Motion passed unanimously

CONSIDER APPOINTMENTS TO JAIL RESTORATION COMMITTEE (See copy attached)

Commissioner Kesling said the Commission has put out an expression of interest to architect firms for the restoration of the Old Jail building. He said the deadline to have those back is December 28th. He said then they will get it out to bid. He said we have to get it done by January 2025 when the new Judge will be coming. Commissioner Siler moved to approve the appointment to the Jail Restoration Committee, as submitted. All yes – Motion passed unanimously

CONSIDER APPROVAL OF COMMISSION PRESIDENT'S SIGNATURE ON HIDTA GRANT DOCUMENTS

Sheriff Elbon said this is a grant they got for the Drug Task Force and they just need the paperwork signed. Commissioner See moved to approve the Commission President's signature on the HIDTA Grant documents, as presented. All yes – Motion passed unanimously

ELECTION OF COMMISSION PRESIDENT FOR 2024

Commissioner Kesling moved to elect Commissioner Siler as Commission President for 2024. Discussion followed: Commissioner Kesling said they have done a lot this past year with getting the Pool up and running, moving the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, got lots of grants, the PRO Officers etc. He said in 2024 they want to renovate the Old County Jail and renovate this annex building for the new Judge. Commissioner See thanked Commissioner Kesling for taking over when he was out with an injury. All yes – Motion passed unanimously


